Dear Prayer Warriors,

Trust you're all well and strengthened by the power of the Holy Spirit.

"When the righteous are in authority, the people rejoice; But when a wicked man rules, the people groan." *Proverbs 29:2 NKJV*

We hear and learn of many countries where God's people and His children are struggling not only with persecution for their faith. Also, under immense struggles and pain with daily life matters and needs. It's almost always because of the ruling of the unrighteous.

We read in *Proverbs 30: 21 – 23 NIV*
