

Introduction


- The journey from Egypt to Canaan has three stages

- Passionate people cannot be hidden and passion for God and His kingdom changes lives and history



















Self centred passion is ungodly



God and the church have been hurt due to the unrighteousness of passionate men and women repeatedly


GOD ORIENTED PASSION
