Dear Friends and Prayer Partners,

And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has **made alive together with Him**, having forgiven you all trespasses, having wiped out the handwriting of requirements that was against us, which was contrary to us. And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross. Having **disarmed principalities and powers**, He made a public spectacle of them, **triumphing over them** in it.” Colossians 2:13-15 NKJV

“If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. **Set your mind on things above**, not on things on the earth. For you died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God.” Colossians 3:1-3 NKJV.

“What then shall we say to these things? *If God is for us, who can be against us?* He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things? Who shall bring a charge against God’s elect? It is **God who justifies**. Who is he who condemns? It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who **also makes intercession for us**. Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?” Romans 8:31-35 NKJV.

“Now if we died with Christ, we believe that **we shall also live with Him**, knowing that Christ, having been raised from the dead, dies no more. Death no longer has dominion over Him. For the death that He died, He died to sin once for all; but the life that He lives, He lives to God. Likewise, you also, reckon yourselves to **be dead indeed to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord**. Therefore, do not let sin reign in your mortal body, that you should obey it in its lusts. And do not present your members as instruments of unrighteousness to sin but present yourselves to God as being alive from the dead, and your members **as instruments of righteousness to God**. For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but under grace.” Romans 6:8-14 NKJV.

“And when I saw Him, I fell at His feet as dead. But He laid His right hand on me, saying to me, **“Do not be afraid;** I am the First and the Last. I am He who lives, and was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore. Amen. And **I have the keys of Hades and of Death.**” Revelation 1:17-18 NKJV

He is alive. The King is alive. He now lives in our hearts.

Because He lives, our debts have been paid, our trespasses have been forgiven and our requirements to fulfill have been wiped out.
