PRAYER NOTE

November 2025

Dear Friends and Prayer Partners,

As God’s children we can access His throne room with boldness and confidence in prayer with a thankful heart.

As we “Lift our Eyes” to God, let us give Him praise and worship, then take a moment to reflect, and let the Holy Spirit cleanse and convict us. *(1 John 1:9)* When I shifted my thoughts from the earth and ourselves to God Himself, we are ready to pray according to His will. *(1 John 5:14-15)*. Then put on the armour of God *(Ephesians 6:14-18)* and get ready to move.

Thankfully, we live in a peaceful country compared with many other countries on earth, but we need to be even more alert lest we fall into lukewarmness or complacency, as we “come to our royal position for such a time as this,” like Esther. *(Esther 4:13-14, 1 Peter 2:1-10)*

For this month may I emphasise two key points as we pray in the war room:

1. Pray for Our Leaders and those in Authority. *(1 Timothy 2:2)*

(May they be in the parliament house, in the workplace, in the church or in our household). We cannot overemphasise the significance of praying for all the leaders on earth. We should even pray for them by name every day. I would like to emphasise this theme in every subtitle we are going to pray about, such as Australia, HCFA, and all nations.

2. Be aware of the time and season we are in, this will keep us alert and be vigilant.

*We are approaching the Christmas season, and life is getting hectic whether we want it or not. Let us not let the enemy have any foothold distracting us with “busyness”.

*It is time to “lift your eyes, shift your thoughts and be ready to move ahead” into 2026. We, as the Kingdom people, can act proactively by the grace of God. Let us come to God and ask Him about His will for us and His plan next year and in the near future. *(Jeremiah 33:3, Proverbs 29:18)*

*We should all be aware that we are living in the end times and we are waiting for the return of our Lord. Let us keep the oil in our lamp by standing in the gap for our family, for each other, the church, and the nations. *(Matthew 25:1-13)*

Here are the suggested starting points for our prayer this month. Please feel free to go with the flow in the Holy Spirit:

Australia:

Repentance

Righteous King, we humble ourselves on behalf of our country. We confess the pride, rebellion, and injustice that have filled our governments—laws that defy Your word, leaders who pursue power over righteousness, and policies that oppress the poor. Forgive us, Lord, for turning away from Your counsel. (*2 Chronicles 7:14; Daniel 9:4–6*)

Australia keeps standing with Israel

Here we especially pray for our stand with Israel as your nation on the international platform. We commit to pray for them as your word calls us to do. We ask for your forgiveness for our leaders in power, who go against your will. We pray for the Holy Spirit to convict them of their need for repentance. We pray for all the people in the troubled Middle East to experience the peace and hope and eternal life through Jesus Christ. We pray for your intervention and your answer to our prayers. (*Numbers 24:9, Genesis 49:9, Genesis 12:3*)

Healing

Father, have mercy on us. There is a lot of brokenness in this land. Here we speak healing, restoration and reconciliation for our Aboriginal brethren, families who came from warzones or natural disaster-affected areas. We speak peace and love over broken relationships, especially in families. Father, give us word to pray, empower us to serve, and bless your people to be a blessing in this country. Here we pray for the church of Australia to rise and influence our ever-changing community with our lives in Christ, fulfilling the church's specific calling in this time.

HCF Australia ministry:

Father, we commit to you all our streams under the ministry of HCF Australia. We pray for more trainers to serve in our Saline Training program. May your Holy Spirit help our CPC stream create deeper, lasting engagement with more churches and believers. You lead us to the content in our website resources to build, edify, inform people to bring glory to your name. We pray for resources to distribute the booklet in the coming year, as we put you first in all we do, and you are our Provider. (*Matthew 6:33*) Please anoint our leaders to deliver spiritual food and a mentoring heart to the healthcare workers. This faithfully through the Discovery Bible Study, CPC meetings, and teaching and through personal encounters in workplaces. Father, we need volunteers with a heart to work among health area workers to coordinate a. Prayer sessions b. Secretarial assistance to liaise with members and friends. Global church revival

Lord of the Harvest, break the chains of comfort and containment. Shatter the spirit of fear and indifference that keeps the Church silent.

Awaken an army of men and women filled with compassion and fire for the lost. Let our hearts burn with urgency and our feet carry the Gospel to the hardest and darkest fields of the earth. (*Isaiah 6:8; Matthew 9:37–38*)

God of Majesty, restore the fear of the Lord to Your Church once again. Overthrow the gods of entertainment, self-promotion, and human wisdom. Let awe return to our gatherings, reverence to our pulpits, and holiness to our altars. May Your tangible glory dwell among us until nations bow and confess that Jesus Christ alone is Lord. (*Habakkuk 2:20; 2 Chronicles 7:1–3*)

Father, we acknowledge our deep need. We do not deserve revival, but we ask for mercy. Rend the heavens and come down. Pour out Your Spirit on every tribe and tongue. Let deep repentance sweep through churches, cities, and nations. Turn hearts back to You. Raise up a global Bride that burns with love for Jesus and labours for His return. (*Isaiah 64:1–2; Joel 2:12–13*)
