As HCFers around the world went to prayer at the beginning of this year, several promises (especially from the book of Isaiah) came into focus in a new and refreshing way. For some, these were a reminder of promises the Lord had given us years ago and there was a sense that the Lord was reminding us that His Word is not limited to human timeframes.

Two other verses (out of a number of others) worth noting were:

We are hoping to appoint representatives from the other Clusters to the GLAT over the next few months.

Living Faith out Loud Conference

Preparations for our global celebrations conference, are moving ahead steadily.

Who should attend the conference?

- Regional leaders, National leaders and Trainers from as many countries as possible.
- Anyone else who would like to be part of what the Lord is doing through the ministry of HCFI.

How do the Training sessions work?

Each **National Fellowship** is encouraged to nominate and support (financially) trainers who can attend the training courses and train others on return to their home countries.

There are 13 training courses listed below. **Regional Leaders** are requested to oversee the nomination of trainers in as many of the T4T courses as possible so that the complete package can be available to the whole region.

- Prayer in the Health Field
- Evangelism in the Health Field
- Disciple Making in the Health Field
- Compassionate Care
- Care of the Care Giver
- Building Resiliency and Preventing Burnout
- Removing the Stones - Inner healing
- Salt and Light in Local Congregations
- Healthy Lifestyles and Longevity
- Servant Leadership in Healthcare
- Church and Healthcare Ministry
- Apologetics for Healthcare Workers
- Blessing our Muslim Colleagues and Patients

In most cases, Trainers will attend the full training of 2 hours per day in their selected courses for 5 days (10 hours of training). The course facilitators will provide pre-reading and take home material (in English) where appropriate. This material can be translated as required by the trainers prior to attending the course.

How do the evening Celebrations work?

Each of the four **Global Clusters** is invited to lead one evening where testimonies, stories, lessons and blessings from the Cluster are shared to inspire the delegates. This can be in the form of presentations, videos, personal testimonies, song items, etc.
