Dear Friends and Prayer Partners,

Let us present our requests to our Heavenly Father and leave everything in His hands, trusting fully that He will answer. There is no need to worry about how God will do it, our role is to believe, to trust, and to remain steadfast in faith.**

**Let this month be marked by unwavering faith, renewed hope, and testimonies of God’s faithfulness in our lives.**
