### PRAYER NOTE - October 2026

Dear Friends and Prayer Partners,

I wonder what thoughts come to our minds when we mention the word ‘prayer’ or ‘praying’? There can be various expressions or demonstrations of prayer influenced by our personality, learned spiritual practices and experiences. No doubt, our best and greatest example of prayer comes from our Lord Jesus Christ himself.

The bible records Jesus praying on many occasions either in solitude (Lk 6:12-13; Mt 26:36;) or in the company of his disciples and followers (at baptism John 3:21; ). His prayer ranged from a simple sentence of thanksgiving (Jn 11:41) to the extensive High priestly prayer of intercession (Jn 17:1-26). Jesus not only modelled a prayer life, but he also taught his disciples to pray (Mt 6: 9 – 13).

We see that, for Jesus, prayer was communication with his Father which was two ways. He talked to His Father, and he also spent time listening to Him(Mt.4). The intimate relationship between them provided the inspiration.

We have been called into the relationship with God through Jesus Christ. Therefore, for us too, prayer is communication with our heavenly Father, an expression of our trust in Him, which springs from a loving relationship with Him. Communication with God strengthens that relationship and gives Him delight.

The invitation is for us to pray **boldly** (Heb.4:16), with **confidence** in Him (Heb 10:19) for Jesus Christ, seated at the right hand of God is continuing to intercede for us. Furthermore, the Holy Spirit helps us (Rom.8:26). Moreover, God is faithful.(1 Thess.5:24)

***“For the eyes of the LORD range throughout the earth to strengthen those whose hearts are fully committed to him.”*** (2 Chr 16:9). Our heavenly Father is eager to bless us.

So, dear friends, what more do we need to persuade us to pray for the kingdom work, HCFA and for the needs listed below?

**Focus on these points and more as the Lord leads when you pray:**

#### **Australia:**

*Praise* God for our country, for the comfort we enjoy and especially for the medical facilities. Pray for the people struggling to cope with the rising cost of living, limited housing and other challenges.

Pray for the political leaders to make decisions that support and empower people of all backgrounds to have a quality life and to live peacefully.

Pray for relevant decision-making groups for wisdom regarding social media, AI related laws.

Pray for people from various cultural and religious background to live with mutual respect.

**HCF Australia ministry:**

*Praise* God for what He is doing through the HCFA ministry.

*Praise* God for those serving on the leadership team and pray that they will continue to unite around God's vision and grow from strength to strength.

Pray for more people to be reached through HCFA ministry.

Pray for the regular CPC seminars and for experienced speakers to equip the believers.

**The Christian Healthcare Workers:**

*Praise* God for the faithful Christian workers in the different parts of health sectors.

Pray that each one of them will walk closely with Lord Jesus, rooted in the Word, filled with love and compassion and experience the joy of serving Him.

Pray for those serving in hostile and/or in areas with limited facilities, for wisdom, strength and safety.

Pray for those in hospitals and clinics serving as support staff or in admin/management roles to serve with an understanding of their role in God's purpose.

Pray that more healthcare workers will respond to His call to serve intentionally in their places of work.

Pray for the workers in their personal needs and struggles - health issues, family needs.

**World/Nations:**

Pray for the people in countries affected by natural disasters; pray for wisdom for their leaders to make appropriate decisions to support those in need.

Pray for a resolution to the USA – Iran – Israel war and for Ukraine – Russia deadlock.

**Church in Australia**

Pray that Churches will be united in Christ, demonstrating God's love and reach out to those who are yet to hear the Good News.
